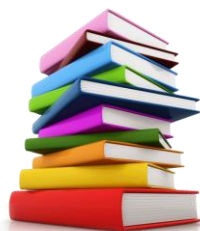


BAGS- BOOKS AND BEYOND !!

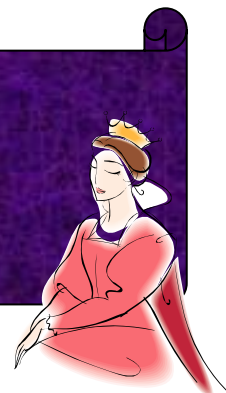
