We often need bakers, help with paperwork or people to help solicit for, or other fundraisers. Let us know what you CAN do! You don't have to attend a meeting to be able to participate !

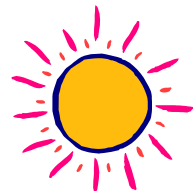
PROGRAM IDEAS !!
